VISION/RECOMMENDATIONS

Sibling relationships are honored and prioritized as critical, lifelong relationships. We support this by:

- <u>Placing siblings together</u> when they enter foster care (preferably with family).
- If siblings must be separated, keep them in the <u>same school district</u> or neighborhood.
- Ensure that their team (social worker, resource caregiver, GAL/CASA, judge) is <u>committed</u> to <u>providing strong, consistent</u> <u>sibling connections</u> (visits, phone/FaceTime, social media, letters/cards, activities, birthdays, holidays, milestones).
- Community members **provide resources and supports** to ensure sibling connections
